SENDIAS is separate from educational settings, the local authority, and health services. SENDIAS is a statutory service (required by law under the Children's and Families Act 2014). It is run by Family Action in Walsall.	Our staff and volunteers have extensive training in SEND law, safeguarding, data protection, and are all DBS checked.

 Empower you to feel confident to express your views and wishes. Help you to understand and exercise your rights. Advise you of your options so you can make an informed decision. Provide templates and examples for letters, emails, and paperwork. Provide resources in various formats to support your query (e.g., webinars and factsheets). Help you to prepare for meetings or tribunals. Accompany you to meetings and tribunals if you are unable to advocate for yourself. Review documents and forms such as EHC.Needs Assessment requests, draft and final EHC Plans and appeal paperwork 	 Make decisions for you, you know your child's and your own wishes and needs best. Attend all meetings. * Arrange meetings or take minutes. * Write letters or emails for you. * Complete paperwork on your behalf. * Print or photocopy documents for you. * SENDIAS does not hold power over the local authority or school policies, procedures and practice. Review benefit forms such as DLA or PIP. *Unless you have additional support needs that mean you cannot undertake these actions independently.
