9 / 11 = (81%) pupils within FSM & LAC cohort achieved above expected progress across all components of the core subjects.

Significant majority within English, Maths and Science achieved above expected progress - showing curriculum stretch.

Improvements / Challenges:

Awaiting results from AP regarding progress / attainment following examinations.

NWa and CWil still secured appropriate attainment levels in English.

Positives:

Positive progress across all aspects of the core curriculum.

Improvements / Challenges:

Statistically not viable.

TBr joined in Yr 11 (AuT Two) but didn't attend enough to even secure a baseline assessment.

Next Steps:

Successful use this year of the Level 2 Award to provide stretch within elements of the English curriculum for those securing Level 1 certificate overall.

Opportunities to explore the impact of City & Guilds Science qualification via Rodbaston Campus - Level 1 Award or Certificate.

Those attending Alternative Provision still secure expected levels of progress and attainment within the core curriculum (to enhance their vocational profile).
